Hon'ble Chief Guest, Dr. G. Narendra Kumar, Secretary, Higher & Technical Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Guests of Honour, Prof. A.K. Bakhshi, Director, ILL, University of Delhi, Shri V.P. Rao, Director, Higher Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Shri Tom Vadakkan, Hon'ble Chairman of the Governing Body, Distinguished Guests, Colleagues, Parents and dear Students, It is my privilege to welcome you all on the occasion of the 19th Annual Day of our college.

Dr.G. Narendra Kumar is the Secretary, Higher and Technical Education, of the Govt. of NCT of the Delhi. Besides being an IAS Officer Dr. Kumar has high academic credentials. He has an M.Sc degree in Chemistry from the Osmania University, which he followed up with an M. Tech. degree in Biochemical Engineering from IIT Delhi. While working in the IAS, he earned his Ph. D. degree in Inorganic Biochemistry from Osmania University. He topped in the Public Administration Masters Program at the World famous Maxwell School of Syracuse University, USA. Besides these degrees, he earned a diploma in Information Technology from the Pondicherry University and Advanced Certificate course in Information Technology Management and Health Services Management from the Syracuse University. He has been a British Chavening Fellow in Environmental Management at the Universities of Manchester and Bradford and a Visiting Fellow at the Universities of Bath and New Castle, UK. He has held several important positions in the IAS, having been Chairman of the Pondicherry Pollution Control Committee for 5 years, besides being Secretary to the Lt. Governor of Pondicherry. He has also been Industries Secretary of Pondicherry and is credited with its development into the Hardware Capital of India. He also worked as an Academic Advisor to the Administrative Staff College of India, where he contributed to Research, Consultancy and Executive Education in the area of Technology Management. He has also developed the National Model Code of Good Governance for the Govt. of India. In

Delhi he has worked as Secretary in the department of Social Welfare where he contributed to the CAPAM award for the Shree Shakti Programme of the Delhi Govt.

Shri V.P. Rao, Director, Higher Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi is a Science and Law Graduate from the University of Delhi. After joining the Administrative Services in 1982 he has worked practically in all the departments of Delhi Govt. including the Secretariat of the Lt. Governor. Despite his busy administrative schedule he continued to take interest in learning and did a Diploma in Russian Language as well as a Certificate course in Solid Waste Management from Loughborough University, U.K.

Dr. A.K. Bakhshi is a Professor in the University of Delhi where he holds the prestigious Sir Shankar Lal Chair of Chemistry since 1996. A double gold medalist, Dr. Bakhshi had his postdoctoral training at the University of Erlangen-Nurnberg, Germany with Prof. J. Ladik and at the Kyoto University and the Institute of Fundamental Chemistry, Kyoto, Japan with Professor K. Fukui, the Nobel Laureate and Prof. T.Yamabe. He has also been a Visiting Scientist at the TIFR, Bombay and the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore.

Currently Professor A.K. Bakhshi is Director of the Institute of Lifelong Learning (ILLL) and also of the Centre for Professional Development in Higher Education (CPDHE) of the University of Delhi. In his present capacity, he has spearheaded the process of e-transformation of University of Delhi.

Prof. Bakhshi's research interests include theoretical polymer chemistry with special reference to electrically conducting polymers and biopolymers. He is the author/coauthor of more than 120 research and education articles, three books and one patent and has guided many students for their Ph.D/M.Phil degrees. He has been the recipient of more than a dozen awards and academic honours including Fellowship of IUPAC and the National Academic Sciences (FNASc). He has been member of the editorial board of the Indian Journal of Chemistry (Section A) and the Journal of Scientific and Industrial Research published by the CSIR. He has been associated with a large number of Academic bodies in various capacities including Chairman.

Prof. Bakhshi has also been very actively associated with the various academic activities of the NCERT, CSIR, UGC, CBSE, and Directorate of Education, All India Radio and Doordarshan including the Chief-Editorship of the UGC-sponsored journal Chemistry Education Review. Last but not the least, Prof. Bakhshi has also the distinction of being the first person from the Universities in India to have been selected as the Member Scientist of the "Third Indian Research Expedition to Antarctica" in 1984.

A Post-graduate in English from the University of Delhi, Mr. Vadakkan started his career in the field of Mass Communication and subsequently decided to join Politics and Social Work. Presently, he is the Secretary, All India Congress Committee and In-charge of Media. He is also the Member Secretary - Hope Foundation, Advisor - All India Consumer Forum, Member – National Central Film Censor Board and Member Kerala Film Censor Board. He has published number of articles in National / International Newspapers and frequently appears on BBC, CNN-IBN, NDTV, Zee News

and other prominent National and Regional Channels. He has numerous awards to his credit, some of which are Indira Gandhi Award, C.G. Janardhan Award for excellence in Social Work, Citizen's Award by FOKANA, USA, Rajiv Gandhi Award for National Integration, Golden Honour Award for Social Service by Kerala Kala Kendram and recently he has been appointed as Coordinator for National Games in Kerala by the Indian Olympic Association. For the last 7 years he is holding the responsibility of the Chairperson of one college or the other in the University of Delhi.

ACTIVITIES IN THE COLLEGE

Orientation Programme

Activities in the college began with the Orientation Programme organized on 14th July, 2008 for the benefit of the first year students. All the first year students were invited to the college alongwith their parents and were apprised of the activities and culture of the college.

Founder's Day

In the convenorship of Dr. Nisha Rana, the college celebrated its Founder's Day on 25th September, 2008, the birth anniversary of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya. Dr. Subramaniyan Swamy the Former Industry and Law Minister, President Janta Party was the Chief Guest on the occasion. Dr. Bajrang Lal Gupta, Kshetriya Saghchaalak presided over the function. Dr. Nand Kishore Garg, Former Chairman, College Governing Body and Mr. Subhash Sachdeva, Member of Legislative Assembly also graced the occasion with their presence. The Principal welcomed the guests and the audience and highlighted the relevance of the day. The Chief Guest Dr. Swamy shared his experiences of academic and political life and emphasized the relevance of the philosophy of Integral Humanism in current scenario. He explained the comprehensive definition of intelligence which includes emotional, social, moral and spiritual intelligence in addition to cognitive intelligence. This spiritual intelligence if developed will act like cosmic energy which we would be able to transmit to all other fellow human beings. Finally he suggested the college to institute a memorial prize in honour of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya which should be awarded to the best essay written on integral humanism by any student of the college and eventually by any student of the University. Dr. Bajrang Lal Gupta explained the concept of Sumanglam, the Bhartiya concept of development which can ensure the all round development of an integral man. This was followed by the investiture ceremony of the newly elected College Student Union. Mr. Rahul Agarwal, Basant Saini, Shaurya Sharma and Sharad Singh were inducted as President, Vice-President, Secretary and Joint Secretary respectively. This was followed by distribution of prizes to students for excellence in House Examination, Attendance and for different Activities. Lastly a Street Play 'Yuvaon Ki Awaz' was presented by College Dramatics Club.

Vande Mataram

The college in collaboration with the Culture Council, University of Delhi has been organizing Vande Mataram for five consecutive years. Continuing with the tradition, the college celebrated Vande Mataram this year too with great fervor and zeal on the 24th September 2008 under the convenorship of Dr. Nupur Verma. This inter-college solo classical dance and choir competition provides a platform to the students from all colleges to exhibit their thoughts through the language of music and dance. The college witnessed a stupendous response from over 20 colleges of University of Delhi. Whereas Hindu College and Shaheed Raj Guru College of Applied Sciences won the first and the second prize in the choir competition, our college bagged the third prize. In the Classical dance competition, the first and second prizes were won by the participants from Lady Shriram college and the third prize was shared by Sri Venkateshwara and Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Colleges.

Music Society

Under the convenorship of Dr. Nupur Verma the college band 'Pluno' and the choreography team actively participated in various competitions organized by the different colleges of the University. Our Choreography team won the first prize in the inter college dance competition held at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences and second prize at both, Shivaji College as well as Moti Lal Nehru College. Raghav Sehgal of B.Com (H) IIIyr. won the Best Drummer award in 'Konkurrenz', the inter-college rock band competition held at our college. Our teams won the first and the second prizes in 'Funky Steps' (girls solo dance competition) and the second prize in the boys solo dance category in the inter-college fest 'Kalarav' held at our college.

VOICE – The Debating Society

The Debating Society began its activity with the Fresher's Talent Hunt on 6th August, 2008 by organizing a debate '**In the opinion of the House - Nuclear deal is in the interest of the Nation**' in which Kanika Tandon and Sumedha shared the first prize, Mohit stood second and Abhishek Kukreja & Surbhi Ajmani stood third. The second inter class debate on '**In the opinion of the House – The students should have the right to evaluate their teachers**' was held on 2nd September, 2009 in which Priyanka Negi and Gaurav Shrivastava stood first and Chiranjeev Thomas and Abhishek Kukreja stood second. In the third Inter class Debate on "**Reality shows like 'Bigboss' degrade our Society**" held on 8th Dec., 2008, Abhishek Kukreja came first, Gulshan Kumar second and Garima third. As a part of our college Cultural Festival 'Kalrav' Dr. R.M. Bhardwaj, Convenor of Debating Society organized an inter college debate competition on the theme '**In the opinion of the House – Live in relationship has come of age in India**'. There were entries from as many as 20 colleges from the University and the Prizes went to Akriti Goel of Shriram College of Commerce (First), Sonal Sharma of Kirori Mal College(2nd) and Karishma Choudhuri of Daulat Ram College(3rd). Although there is

not much to boast of in the inter-college debate competitions, nevertheless our promising debators Gulshan Kumar, Abhishek Kukreja, Pankaj Tiwari, Bhoovan Suraj, Saba Sinha, Gaurav Srivastava, Priyanka Negi and Rahul Bhatia performed well and got applause in some of the prestigious inter-college debates at Ramjas, Gargi, Hansraj, Shyama Prasad Mukherjee, Deshbandhu and Kirorimal colleges, at times missing positions by a whisker.

Dramatics Club - Yavanika

Yavanika has been redefining dramatics over the years, and the performance done by its active members has added to the coinage. Initially, there was an “inter-class skit competition” for the 1st yr. students with the motive of having new members for the society. Three plays, ‘**Journey of India**’, ‘**Yuvaon Ki Awaz**’ & ‘**Kosi Kinare**’ were self written and directed by the members of Yavanika. After getting appreciation for its first performance at college Founder’s Day the street play Production, ‘Yuvaon Ki Awaz’ was taken to many inter-college competitions. It had the privilege of winning 1st prize at Vivekananda Institute of Professional Studies. The Journey of success continued at the Annual Festival of BITS Pilani where our team participated in different events like ‘Act & React’, ‘Mime-Act’ etc. Out of 20 different college teams participating from all over India, our team got the **2nd position in the event ‘Act & React’**. Considering that the competition was at its peak, this definitely is the most remarkable win by Yavanika. Props in place, spotlight on, yes the stage was set for another spell binding annual theatre production. In the past years, Yavanika has already taped plays like Yaad Karo Kurban, Adhe Adhure, Godan, Konark & William Shakespeare’s ‘A Mid Summer Nights Dream’.

This year, Yavanika staged ‘**Swami Ji**’ – a play written by Dr. C.D. Sidhu & directed by Mr. Ravi Taneja. All the performers flaunted their expertise in acting and the play was huge success. The play was also taken to the “Natya Samrat Samaroh” – a professional theatre festival. Annual Cultural Festival KALARAV

College festival Kalrav –08 was organized on 15th & 16th December 2008 by the Student Activity Board under the convenorship of Dr. Kulvinder Singh and active involvement of the Student's Union. This year the festival was organized with much wider participation.

Event started with Chief Guest, Dr. M. Sayeed Alam, an eminent play writer and director inaugurating the function with lightening of lamp. In his inaugural speech he emphasised on the importance of cultural activities in development of student personality. He suggested the activities may be organized even in classrooms, so that larger number of students can participate. Our principal in his speech gave an account of various multidimensional activities organized by the college at various levels.

Next event was western group dance competition. Ten colleges participated in the competition. I.P. college got the first prize and Shriram college of commerce and Kirorimal college got the second and third prizes respectively. Konkurrenzz – the band competition was the next intercollege competition. Nine bands of various colleges participated in the event. In the evening live rock show was performed by Bandish band. Student enjoyed the band performance the most.

Street play competition was organized on 16th December. Gargi college, Khalsa college and Kamla Nehru college got 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes respectively. Solo dance competition was the main attraction. There were 27 entries from various colleges. First prize in women category went to Madhu of D.D.U.C.

This year Kalrav also organized an inter-college debate. Thirty two students from twenty various college participated in the debate. Akriti Goel of SRCC won the first prize, Sonal Sharma of Kirori Mal college won second prize and Karishma chaudhary of Daulat Ram college got third prize in the debate.

Eco-Club

The Eco-club under the Convenorship of Dr. Veena Jain of the Department of Operational Research enrolled 30 students as members, of which 10 were appointed volunteers for organization of the activities throughout the year. The first activity organized by the Eco-club was a discussion on **“Waste Disposal – Remedies to Reduce the Menace”**. As an outcome of the discussion the Club decided to sensitise the college fraternity towards segregation of Bio-degradable and non bio-degradable wastes and accordingly got implemented separate bins for collection of the two kinds of waste. To create awareness about importance of Conservation of Water, a poster making and card making competition on the theme **“Rain Water Harvesting - the Need of the Hour”** was organized on 10th Sept., 2008.

Mayank Sharma of B.Sc. Physical Sciences II year and Amrita Kumari of B.Sc Life Sciences I Year won the first and second prizes in poster making competition., while Pooja Negi of B.Sc Applied Physical Sciences, I Year won the prize in the Card Making Event . A Creative Writing competition **“Is the Demand for the Bio-fuel – a threat to the World Food Supply”** was held on 26th Nov., 2008. The first, second and third prizes were won by Jyotsna of B.Sc.Life Sciences I year , Renu Bansal of B.Sc(H) Electronics III Year and Mamta of B.Sc.Life Sciences I Year respectively. Five students of the Eco-club namely Himani, Sanyukta, Divya, Rishab, and Naveen of B.Sc Applied Physical Science, III Year attended the Eco-meet organized by Delhi government at Pragati Maidan from 14th to 17th December 2008. The meet stressed on using natural products rather than artificial ones and emphasised the 3 R’s i.e. reduce, reuse and recycle. The club also took upon itself promotion of the Science Promotion Scheme of the Delhi Council of Science and Technology (DCST) , Department of Environment and organised the first lecture of the series. Dr. R.G. Sharma, Project Scientist in Inter-University Accelerator Centre delivered a talk on **“Exciting Applications of Superconductors”** on 10th February, 2009. Akanksha of B.Sc Applied Physical Sciences III Year of our college undertook a project **“How Green is our College”** to assess the consumption of energy resources by collecting the data pertaining to the college. The activities of the Club were concluded by a Collage Making Competition on the theme **“Our Earth, Our Future”** held on 18th February, 2009 in which 25 students participated. The first prize went to a team of Priyanka Hooda, Neha, and Sanyukta of B.Sc Applied Physical Science III Year, second to Naveen Ranjan of the same class and third prize to Raju of B.Sc Physical Science II Year.

Photographic Club

It is indeed a great pleasure to pen down the first report of the Photography Club. The college initiated yet another activity in the college to provide a forum to students’ creativity. The Photography club had its inaugural function on 30th August 2008. On this occasion the college invited Shri Hemant Kumar to deliver a lecture on various aspects of creative photography. Thereafter the college in collaboration with KABERI organized an eight week workshop on creative photography to enable the interested students learn and understand the nuances of photography. The workshop comprised theory classes, outdoor shooting and night photography. These classes were conducted in the college premises and amidst the ruins of Puraana Quilla. The Inter-college Photography Competition was one of the highlights of colleges’ students’ festival Kalrav 2008 where various colleges of Delhi University participated. The first prize for the theme based activity went to **Bhaskarachrya College** and the first prize from the open theme was begged by **St. Stephens College**. The second prize for both the categories went to DDUC. The competition was adjudged by Ms Geeta and Shri Hemant Kumar. Finally, the students showcased their acquired skills through an exhibition that was put up during the festival Kalrav 2008. The exhibition was highly appreciated by both staff and students.

NSS Committee

It has been an extremely active year for the NSS unit of the college. Fifty students from various courses enrolled for NSS. These students regularly visited a number of institutions to help the under-privileged and needy. With the encouragement from NSS Prog. Officer, Dr. Shashi Saxena they went to Blind School, Panchkuiyan Road, Blind School, Vikaspuri, Hostel for the Blind Girls, Dwarka, Braille Library, Univ. of Delhi, Blind School, Mangolpuri, Shikha Pathashala, Shadipur Depot (A school for the slum children), Vasudev Shiksha Smarak Chatrivity, Madipur Village (A day care centre for slum children), Govt. Primary School, Karampura, Friends Society for Physically Challenged, Karampura, Some of the students also took up cleaning work in the college campus. Nine students attended a one day symposium on Regional Identities and Indian Ethos organized by Univ. of Delhi. Five NSS Volunteers attended a two days leadership orientation programme held at Rajdhani College, organized by NSS Unit of Univ. of Delhi. A lecture by the Chairperson of 'Jamghat'- an organization working for the welfare of street children was organized by the NSS Unit. NSS volunteers and many other students actively participated. A seminar on 'Agrarian Crises in India' was also organized by the NSS unit. In the seminar presentation was made by Perspectives – a group of teachers and students from DU and JNU. Students and teachers of other colleges of University of Delhi also attended the seminar.

SPORTS

The Sports Committee under the convenorship of Dr. Ram Pal & active guidance of Dr. Anek Goel has taken keen interest in keeping the spirits high. Our college has shown its presence in the sporting scenario of not only the university system but also at National level. At All India Inter-Varsity tournament and Nationals our students represented University of Delhi and Delhi State respectively and brought laurels.

SUBJECT SOCIETIES

Abhivyakti

Abhivyakti, a forum of the teachers and students of social sciences and humanities began its activities with a Fresher's Welcome Party on 18th Sept., 2008 in the college in which the newly admitted students exhibited their artistic talent in the field of singing, dancing and poetry recitation. Dr. R.M. Bhardwaj threw light on the importance of celebrating Fresher's Party. On 20th Sept., 2008 Abhivyakti organized Hindi Divas with a lecture by Dr. Suresh Dhingra from Shraddhanand College. On 22nd Dec., 2008 the society organized another lecture on 'Role of Media against Terrorism' by Dr. Anil Singh which was attended by a good number of students and teachers.

Aryabhatta Science Forum

Aryabhatta Science Forum under the Convenorship of Dr. Poonam Suri organized **Converging Vectors** - an inter-college Paper presentation competition. Padamshree Prof. K.L. Chopra, Former Director of IIT Kharagpur was the Chief Guest and delivered enlightening talk on “Nanoscience and Nanotechnology demystified”. There was wide participation of 10 colleges in this event. Paper presentation by students was conducted in three parallel sessions one each for Physics, Electronics and Computer Science. Each session was judged by two external judges. In physics session, the first prize was shared by Doon Valley Institute of Engg. & Tech., Karnal and Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College. The second prize was bagged by Shivaji College. In Electronics session, the first and second prizes were won Acharya Narendra Dev College and Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College. In Computers, both the prizes were won by Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College.

Charak Sushrut Biochemical Society

The Charak Sushrut Biochemical Society started the year with an inaugural lecture on **Discovery of DNA molecule**, by **Prof. SC Maheshwari**, Department of Botany, University of Delhi, on September 1, 2008. The Society also organized a full day event, **EMISSION 2008**, on December 6, 2008, which comprised of a number of activities *viz.* Science Quiz, Dumb Charades, Poster making and Paper Presentation. The event was a huge success with participation of more than 100 students from all the science courses. A valedictory lecture by **Prof. VP Singh**, Department of Botany, University of Delhi, was also organized by the Society on February 23, 2009. Prof. Singh apprised the audience about the **Microbial World**.

English Society

ZEST

The English Society ZEST under the aegis of Department of English DDUC believes in taking knowledge beyond classrooms. The objective of the society is to explore various dimensions of the English Language Literature course and discover its applicability in the outside world. The society organizes events which enhance and enrich the vistas of the students in associated arts like Theatre, Cinema, Paintings and Sculpture.

The Society runs a Film Club and regularly screens world classics to sensitise students towards the nuances of Cinema and provide ideological exposure. The English Society met every Friday afternoon for an intense academic session. The Senior students who have passed out from the college and are at present pursuing their masters in English held text based workshops to provide the students with an easy familiarity with the text and secondary readings based on the texts. The Dedicated Friday afternoon slots were also used for Lecture series by subject specialists.

The Department of English has also introduced two add-on courses, one on ELT (English Language Teaching) and another on E.C.P.DT (effective communication and personality development through theatre) which helps in the overall development of the students.

The Department of English this year held two one day English Grammar Workshops for the students of B.A programme in Sept '09. Two Special lectures by Dr. Nirmalya Samanta Associate, Coordinator ILL South Campus were organised on Literature & Art and W.B.Yeats. Library

Our College Library has state of the art centralized computing facility comprising of 40 advanced PC's with printers. All the PCs are networked with Internet access facility. Through the University Radio Link network more than 10,000 peer reviewed journals, e-text books and other educational material can be accessed. This facilitates and make e-learning possible among students thus supplementing classroom teaching. Syllabi of different courses have been downloaded and scanned question papers of university annual examinations are made available to students on this network for their ready reference.

Our library is fully computerized and all its functions and operations are done through a dedicated network of advanced computer systems and library software. It has up-to-date bibliographic database of books and journals. The library has added 800 volumes of books in it collection so far this year, making its total collection to 29,530 books. It has a total of 60 subscriptions of journals in the relevant subject fields which are of national and international repute. Besides this the library has 400 bound volumes of journals and 450 CD's in its collection.

Two days workshop was organized for Software and Hardware Solutions : ‘The Troubleshooters’, which helped the students to know the basics of Hardware and finding solutions for some of the hardware selected problems.

One session was organized where experts from ‘Kavalry’ Institute talked on career opportunities in Defence.

Academic Achievements

The upward trend in the quality of result was maintained consecutively for the 10th year. The number of students passing in first division increased to 576 compared to 556 last year. In PGDCA First Semester examination both first and second positions were bagged by our students. Vandana Mittal stood first in the University with 78% marks while Arti Gupta stood second in the University with 69% marks. In PGDCA Second Semester examination the first three positions in the University were obtained by our students. Arti Gupta stood first in the University with 80.9% marks, while Vandana Mittal stood second with 76.6% marks and Kamna Thukral was adjudged third in the University with 68% marks. In PGDCA final year Inder Singh stood first in the University with 76.9% and Jyoti stood third in the University with 72.6% marks.

The first batch of English (Hons.) students passed out this academic year. Of the 13 students who passed the examination three secured first division and 7 students high second division. Ashok Kumar secured 64% marks with 6th rank in the North Campus colleges.
